	Prehistory is the time that happened before humans had writing, many thousands of years ago, a very long time in the past.
	<p>Stone Age (pre-3300BCE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When the first humans began to live in Europe. People lived in caves. Hunter-gatherers, travelling around to find food. 
	<p>Bronze Age (3300—1200 BCE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bronze is a metal. People lived in settlements in a group of round houses. Making tools from bronze meant people could grow food as well as hunt and forage. 
	<p>Iron Age (1200-600 BCE):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Iron is a metal. People lived together in bigger groups. They built forts to defend themselves. Tools were made from iron Humans farmed the land instead of hunting.
